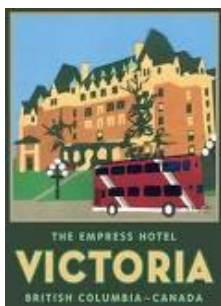
SUNDAY MAY 22 18:30 – Welcoming Reception

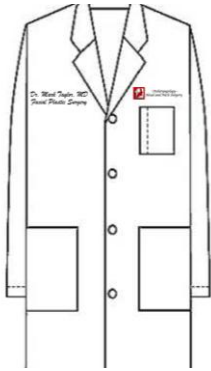
