The fellowship post is a full time paid position and includes being first on call (1 in 4 roster). This is a General ORL fellowship and involves 3 x 4 month rotations through combinations of Head & Neck, Rhinology, Otology, Paediatrics and Laryngology working with 5 consultants based in Dunedin with operating sessions & clinics also occurring in Invercargill and Oamaru.

The service also deals with a large number of skin cancers. The department is linked to the University of Otago and the fellow will have under & post graduate teaching commitments.

The post is for 1 year and usually runs from July to July.

The successful applicant will have to be eligible for, and gain temporary registration with the New Zealand Medical Council.
