The Division of Pediatric Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery at British Columbia Children's Hospital (BCCH) is seeking a locum Pediatric Otolaryngologist to fill a full-time position. The position is open immediately until March 31, 2022. Start date is flexible.

The successful candidate will join as one of 5 full-time equivalent Pediatric Otolaryngologists at a freestanding Children's Hospital built in 2017. BCCH serves as the only dedicated tertiary centre for infants and children throughout the province of British Columbia and the Yukon (population 5 million). The candidate will work in a highly-collaborative teaching environment with nurses, allied health professionals, fellows, residents, and medical students. They will join a busy clinical practice including dedicated operating room time, involvement in several multi-disciplinary clinics and clinical outreach including servicing Indigenous communities. The position will be salaried.

The ideal candidate will have: completed fellowship training in Pediatric Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery; certification in Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (or equivalent); and must be eligible for licensure by the College of Physicians and Surgeons of BC.
