

Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgeon- Guelph, Ontario

Guelph Facial Plastics, a boutique, high-end, and growing facial plastic and reconstructive surgery practice in Guelph, ON is seeking an Associate Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgeon to join the practice. The practice is owned and operated by a double board-certified facial plastic surgeon Dr. Matthew Brace and specializes in skin cancer reconstruction, maxillofacial trauma, septorhinoplasty, cosmetic facial plastic surgery and non-surgical facial cosmetic procedures.

In this role the associate surgeon would be responsible for sharing in the surgical care of OHIP referred patients with skin cancer, facial trauma, and functional septorhinoplasty concerns while building their cosmetic practice. The surgeon would be expected to be comfortable, knowledgeable, and skilled in hyaluronic acid injectables and neurotoxins.

The practice has two dedicated cosmetic patient care coordinators, a full time and a part time clinic nurse, and administrative support staff. The practice boasts 10,000 sq ft spread over 2 stories with the second floor occupied by clinical consult rooms, two clinic minor procedure rooms, a clinical photography room including the Vectra imaging camera system, and private administrative office space. CO2 laser, pulsed dye laser, Profound RF micro needling and Sublative skin resurfacing technologies are on site.

The main floor houses Guelph Surgical Suites, a private level 3 accredited 2 operating room facility with in-house sterilization. Virtual tours can be viewed at www.facialplastics.ca and www.surgicalsuites.ca.

Opportunities for teaching and research in the practice exist as Dr. Brace is academically involved in teaching the 4th year McMaster Otolaryngology residents for month long facial plastics rotations. He is also a part of the University of Toronto Division of Facial Plastic and Reconstructive surgery as well as a lecturer for Western University Otolaryngology.

Call duties, OR and ambulatory care resources to be shared with Dr. Brace at Guelph General Hospital.

Requirements for the position include medical degree approved by, and license through, the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO), post graduate training in Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery or Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery (FRCS), and subspecialty training in Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery. ABFPRS accredited training and certification is an advantage but not a requirement.

Compensation is negotiable between independent billing with a cost sharing model vs salaried position with profit sharing.
