

University of British Columbia Head and Neck Surgical Oncology Fellowship: Drs. Don Anderson, Scott Durham, Eitan Prisman

Duration: 12 months; July 1 to June 31

Description: This is a comprehensive Head and Neck Surgical oncology fellowship experience with three head and neck microvascular oncology surgeons at a tertiary/quaternary academic hospital servicing British Columbia. The clinical experience is both ablative and reconstructive including over 100 free flap reconstructions, over 30 Trans Oral Robotic Surgeries, Transoral Laser Microsurgery, open craniofacial resections and endocrine surgeries. The academic experience includes preparing Head & Neck Tumor boards, Teaching of residents and medical students, and 2 clinical research projects. The clinical/academic split is 80/20 and includes dedicated time with Radiation/Medical Oncology at the BC Cancer Agency. The average weekly schedule includes 3-days OR, 1-day clinic and 1-day research. Interested candidates are encouraged to arrange for a site visit.
