Adjacent to KGH is the state of the art Interior Heart & Surgical Centre featuring; 9 specialized Operating Rooms created for Thoracic, Urology, Neurosurgery, Vascular, Plastics, Obstetrics/Gynecology, Otolaryngology , Orthopedics, General and Trauma surgeries with 2 ORs dedicated to Cardiac.

Our recently opened Centennial Building boasts an expanded emergency and ambulatory care department, larger operating rooms and a rooftop helipad. KGH is a teaching centre for the Southern Medical Program affiliated with UBC, and is entering its third year of training Royal College Emergency Medicine Physicians.
