Otolaryngologist – Head & Neck Surgeon Specialist in Otoneurology and Lateral Skull Base Surgery

Position Description

The ENT-HNS service of the CHU de Québec is seeking an otolaryngologist – head & neck surgeon to fulfill a permanent full-time position with subspecialty in otoneurology and lateral skull base surgery. The candidate would have to provide outpatient and inpatient care, surgical care for tertiary otoneurology cases (including lateral skull base tumors and auditory brainstem implants) as well as general otolaryngology. An average of 6 OR days per month will be provided, depending on the surgical cases load. The position also includes clinical and formal teaching at Laval University Faculty of Medicine, and participating in scientific research activities.

Qualifications

- Certification with the Royal College of Surgeons of Canada in Otolaryngology and Head & Neck Surgery
- A 2 years fellowship training in otoneurology / lateral skull base surgery, with 1 year dedicated to scientific research
- Ability to work in French
- Eligible for licensure with the Collège des médecins du Québec

Remuneration

The remuneration in the Province of Quebec is based on a fee-for-service system through the provincial Health Insurance system.
