



## Otologist/Neurotologist Dalhousie University

The Division of Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery is seeking applicants who wish to pursue an academic career in Otology/Neurotology at Dalhousie University. The successful fellowship trained candidate will join the other staff surgeon to offer tertiary care in the areas of skull base surgery, chronic middle ear disease, pediatric and adult cochlear implantation, and hearing/balance. Protected and full funded research time is available and encouraged. The Division offers competitive alternate funding compensation combined with a young and vibrant faculty which makes this a tremendous opportunity for interested candidates. The successful candidate will have the ability to collaborate with a well established Ear and Auditory Research (EAR) lab connected to our Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery clinic.

The QEII Health Sciences Centre is the principal teaching hospital affiliated with Dalhousie University and a centre for excellence in health care research. It provides core health services to 500,000 Halifax region residents (50% of the population of Nova Scotia) and tertiary and quaternary acute care services to residents of Atlantic Canada. All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply; however, Canadians citizens and permanent residents will be given priority.
