

Pembroke Regional Hospital is currently seeking: Full-Time Otolaryngologist

The Hospital is situated on the shores of the Ottawa River close to the Algonquin Park and provides an array of Diagnostic and Laboratory Services including: Nuclear Medicine, CT and MRI. Full specialist support including: a Hospitalist Program, Anaesthesia, Internal Medicine, Surgery, OBGYN, Psychiatry, Orthopaedics, Otolaryngology, and Urology.

Pembroke Regional Hospital (PRH) is a referral hospital supporting smaller hospitals in the Ottawa Valley serving a population of 100,000. The Emergency Department (ED) sees approximately 36,000 visits a year divided between acute care and fast track areas. We are a designated District Stroke Centre with a Neurologist on-call 24/7 through telemedicine. The ED/ICU is staffed by a multi-disciplinary team of nurses, physicians, respiratory therapists; as well as, social services, pastoral care, crisis intervention, speech, occupational and physio therapists. We have well established referral protocols with local tertiary care centres 140 km away in Ottawa.
