**THE POSITION: Otolaryngologist - Head and Neck Surgeon**

**POSITION DESCRIPTION:**

Horizon Health Network, Saint John area (Region 2), is actively seeking a permanent full-time Otolaryngologist-Head & Neck Surgeon. The physician shall provide both inpatient and outpatient services and will provide on-call coverage in coordination with four (4) other members of the Division of Otolaryngology.

Department of Surgery members are encouraged to be part of the surgical teaching program affiliated with Dalhousie University Medical School and Memorial University Medical School postgraduate program and teaching in the undergraduate program at Dalhousie Medicine New Brunswick. Information regarding faculty appointments is available upon request. Physicians are also encouraged to be part of the research program.

**QUALIFICATIONS:**

- A medical degree is required.
- Certification with the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons Canada in Otolaryngology / Head and Neck Surgery.
- Fellowship training is not required.
- Candidates must be eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of New Brunswick.
- Proficiency in English is required. Bilingual skills would be considered an asset.

**CALL SCHEDULE:**

- Hours of work: Full-time
- On call requirements: 1:5

**REMUNERATION:**

Fee-For-Service which is a direct compensation between the physician and Medicare New Brunswick.

**INCENTIVES:**

- Moving Expense Allowance of up to \$8,000 with a Return of Service Agreement of two (2) years.
- Recruitment incentives may be available for Medical Residents & new physicians who meet the eligibility criteria and are conditional to the acceptance of an employment offer and are subject to Department of Health pre-approval and annual budget allocation for each fiscal year (with a Return of Service Agreement of two (2) years to four (4) years).

- July 2024 anticipated, but able to accommodate later starts for the right candidate.
