



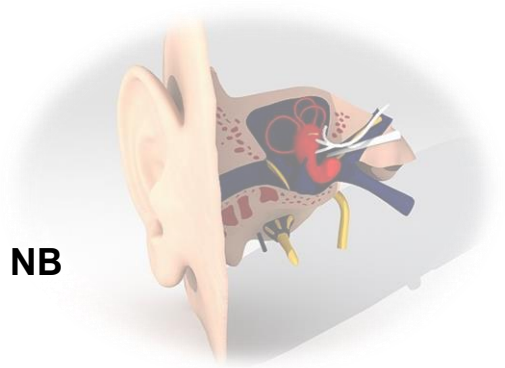

INTRODUCTION

Introduction: Otologic conditions are common in an otolaryngology practice but ear surgery has dramatically decreased in volume in the general otolaryngology practice. The aim of this course is to refresh common open otologic procedures for those in the community as well as enhance what was taught during residency for the more junior surgeons.

A half day didactic course taught by some of the most experienced Canadian otologists will compliment a half-day of hands on dissection on fresh frozen cadaveric heads. The participant will be given a hands-on opportunity to be guided through mastoidectomy approaches, middle ear procedures such as tympanoplasty and ossiculoplasty. Participants will also be given the opportunity to attempt cochlear implant electrode insertions and bone conduction device placements.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

After attending this workshop, the participant will be able to -

1. Perform a basic cortical mastoidectomy as well as understand common indications for this procedure
2. Elevate a simple tympanomeatal flap, inspect the ossicular chain and perform basic tympanoplasty and ossiculoplasty techniques
3. Understand indications for cochlear implants and bone conduction implants
4. Be familiar with common otological instruments and handling of otologic drills.
