

Permanent Full-time Otolaryngologist

Head and Neck Surgeon

The Opportunity

Our team of Otolaryngology - Head and Neck Surgeons, is looking for a fifth member to join our team on a permanent full-time basis. The successful candidate will have three (3) to four (4) days of OR time per month and will take one (1) in four (4) or five (5) call covering Peterborough Regional Health Centre (PRHC) and smaller surrounding hospitals. The on-call surgeon is not required to travel to surrounding hospitals. Patients are transferred to PRHC when assessment by Otolaryngology – Head and Neck surgery is necessary. The following surgical specialties are represented in Peterborough: General Surgery, Gynecology, Otolaryngology—Head and Neck, Vascular, Orthopedics, Plastics, Ophthalmology, Oral Maxillofacial Surgery and Urology.

Remuneration is via fee-for-service billing to the Ontario Health Insurance Plan (OHIP). Minimum expected annual earnings for a full-time practicing Otolaryngologist working at our hospital and in our region is more than \$450,000. Benefits are not applicable for this position. Language of work is English.

Job Duties & Qualifications

- Functions as a general Otolaryngologist and provides regional on call coverage
- Registered (or eligible for registration) with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario
- Applicants must be eligible for independent CPSO licensure and have obtained or be eligible to obtain specialty qualifications from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada
- Strong interpersonal skills and ability to work effectively with physicians, nursing, staff, patients, directors, managers, and the community
- Evidence of ongoing continued medical education.
