Microvascular Surgery Fellowship

The microvascular surgery fellowship at the University of Western Ontario was established in 2006 and has trained 15 fellows. The focus of the fellowship is microvascular and pedicled flap reconstructions. There are approximately 85-105 free flaps and 50 pedicled flaps performed each year. The fellow is the primary surgeon for these cases.

The residents are primary surgeons for the ablation, however the fellowis always welcome to be a second assist and will have selected opportunities to take residents through neck dissections. We also carry out approximately 30 transoral robotic surgery cases per year mainly for the identification of unknown primaries. The fellow is primary surgeon for the majority of these cases.

The fellowship is offered annually with the next position available for July 2024-2025. The application deadline is March 1st, 2023. Interested applicants should email their full CV and 3 letters of reference. We will be contacting a subset of candidates for virtual interviews in March 2023.
